Cutting Instructions: Flying Geese Template G-1

Accent Fabric #A-1 through #A-8, Bag #1 & #2

Eight (8) fabrics are used to cut the pieces for the flying geese. Twenty (24) pieces are cut from each fabric.

Note: If you plan to use more or less than eight (8) fabrics make sure you cut (192) triangles for the geese.

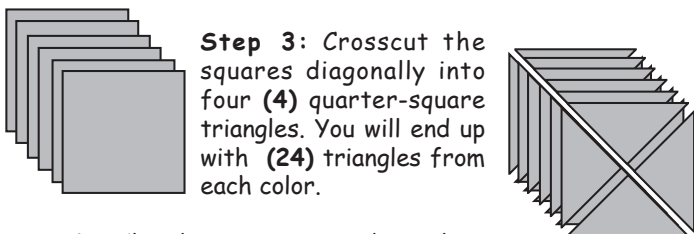
Step 1: Cut one (1) 5" by 42" strip selvage to selvage from each of the eight (8) fabrics. A total of eight (8) strips are needed.



Step 2: Open up each strip, stack them *right-side-up*. Sub-cut six (6) 5" squares from each color.



Step 3: Separate the pieces by color into eight (8) stacks.



Step 4: Clip the pieces together, place sixteen (16) pieces from each color into Bag #1, and place eight (8) pieces from each color into Bag #2.



The total # of geese in Bag #1 is 128.
The total # of geese in Bag #2 is 64.

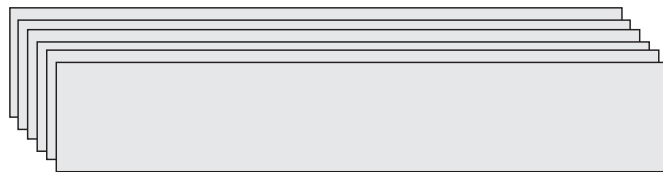
Cutting Instructions: Unit G1, G2L, & G2R

Background Fabric #B-3, Bag #1 & #2

Template Layout Sheets were designed to cut the background pieces for the geese. There are four (4) Template Layout sheets.

Background Template Layout Sheet: Unit G1-2 and Unit G1-3
Background, Template Layout Sheet: Unit G2-2 and Unit G2-3

Step 1: Cut six (6) 7-1/2" by 42" strips selvage to selvage from background fabric #B-3.



Step 2: Open up the strips, stack them *right-side-up*, and sub-cut eight (8) 7-1/2" by 5-1/4" rectangles from each strip. You will end up with six (6) pieces in each stack.



Step 3: The pieces are now re-stacked into six (6) groups of eight (8) pieces. Make sure the pieces are all facing *right-side-up* in each pile.
