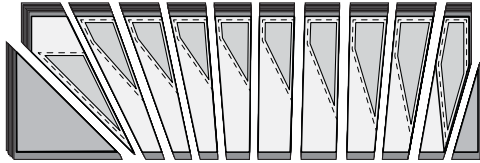
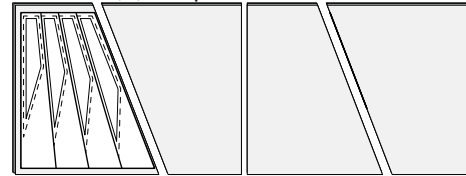


Step 3: Slice through the paper and fabric in numerical order, to separate the template pieces for each section.



Step 4: Clip the templates and fabric pieces together for each section. At this time place the pieces in Bag #18 with the foundation papers for Unit-X.

Step 2: Position the *Unit-X Spike Template Layout Sheet 2*, (Bag #18) onto the (2) strips.



Note: Again, the Template Layout Sheet must be positioned as though fitting two layout sheets onto your stack. Place the layouts as shown and cut along the longest edge to divide the strip evenly into four pieces.

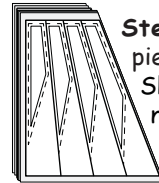
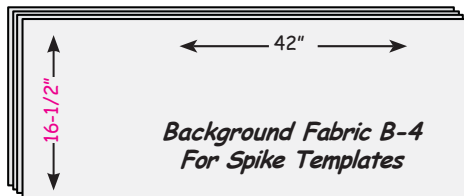
Cutting Instructions Unit-X, Bag #18

Unit-X: Background Fabric B-4

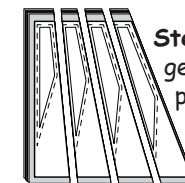
Sections (9, 11, 13, 15, 17 & 19)

Unit-X, Spike Template Layout Sheet 1

Step 1: Cut (6) 16-1/2" by 42" strips across the width of the fabric. Stack (4) strips facing *right-side-up*. Set the other two strips with *Unit-X Spike Template Layout Sheet 2* (Bag #18).

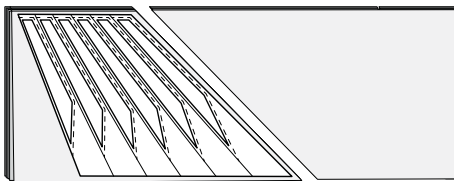


Step 3: Restack the fabrics into one set of (8) pieces. Reposition the layout sheet to fit as shown. Slice through the paper and fabric on Lines 1-3, in numerical order, to separate the template pieces for each section.



Step 4: Clip the templates and fabric pieces together for each section. At this time place the pieces in Bag #18 with the foundation papers for Unit-X.

Step 2: Position the *Unit-X Spike Template Layout Sheet 1* onto the four strips.



Note: Again, the Template Layout Sheet must be positioned as though fitting two layout sheets onto your stack. Place the layouts as shown and cut along the longest edge to divide the strip evenly into two pieces.

Step 3: Restack the fabrics into one set of (8) pieces. Reposition the layout sheet to fit as shown. Slice through the paper and fabric on Lines 1-5, in numerical order, to separate the template pieces for each section.

Step 4: Clip the templates and fabric pieces together for each section. At this time, place the pieces in Bag #18 with the foundation papers for Unit-X.

Unit-Y: Accent Fabric A-6

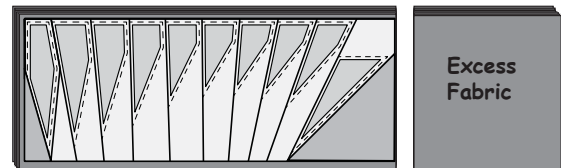
Sections (2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16, 18 & 20)

Unit-Y, Background Template Layout Sheet

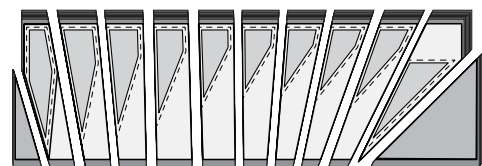
Step 1: Cut (8) 12-1/2" by 42" strips across the width of the fabric. Stack the strips facing *right-side-up*.



Step 2: Position the *Unit-Y Background Template Layout Sheet* (Bag #19) onto the eight strips.



Step 3: Slice through the paper and fabric in numerical order, to separate the template pieces for each section.

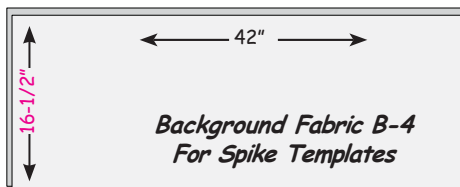


Step 4: Clip the templates and fabric pieces together for each section. At this time place the pieces in Bag #18 with the foundation papers for Unit-Y.

Sections (1, 3, 5, & 7)

Step 1: Stack the remaining (2) strips facing *right-side-up*.

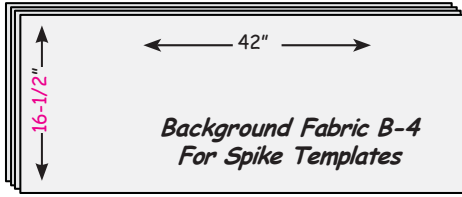

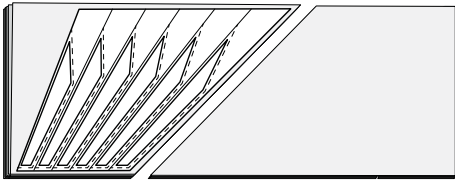
Sections (9, 11, 13, 15, 17 & 19)

Unit-Y, Spike Template Layout Sheet 1

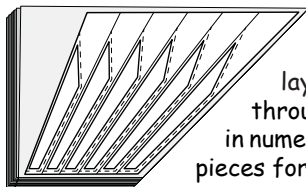
Step 1: Cut (6) 16-1/2" by 42" strips across the width of the fabric. Stack (4) strips facing *right-side-up*. Set the other two strips with *Unit-Y Spike Template Layout Sheet 2*. (Bag #19)



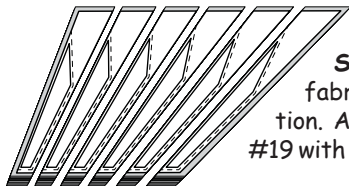
Step 2: Position the *Unit-Y Spike Template Layout Sheet 1*, (Bag #19) onto the four strips.



Note: Again, the *Template Layout Sheet* must be positioned as though fitting two layout sheets onto your stack. Place the layouts as shown and cut along the longest edge to divide the strips evenly into two pieces.



Step 3: Restack the fabrics into one set of (8) pieces. Reposition the layout sheet to fit as shown. Slice through the paper and fabric on Lines 1-5, in numerical order, to separate the template pieces for each section.



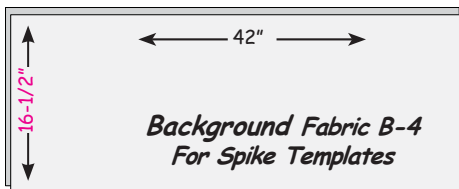

Sections (1, 3, 5, & 7)

Unit-Y, Spike Template Layout Sheet 2

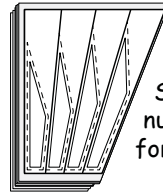
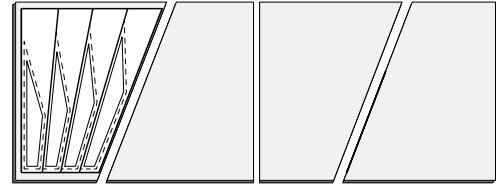
Step 1: Stack the remaining (2) strips facing *right-side-up*.



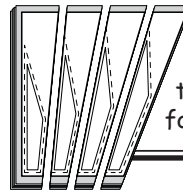
Step 2: Position the *Unit-Y Spike Template Layout Sheet 2*, (Bag #19) onto the four strips.



Note: Again, the *Template Layout Sheet* must be positioned as though fitting two layout sheets onto your stack. Place the layouts as shown and cut along the longest edge to divide the rectangle evenly into four pieces.



Step 3: Restack the fabrics into one set of (8) pieces. Reposition the layout sheet to fit as shown. Slice through the paper and fabric on Lines 1-3, in numerical order, to separate the template pieces for each section.



Step 4: Clip the templates and fabric pieces together for each section. At this time, place the pieces in Bag #18 with the foundation papers for Unit-Y.

Sorting and Stacking

Before you begin paper piecing, match the template and fabric pieces for both units up with the Sec. #s on the foundation papers. The stacking process begins with Sec. 20 on the bottom, finishing with Sec. 1 on top.
