# Please make sure you bring the following items to class. The are essential to the techniques taught in class.

Which Way's North Pattern (purchase at <u>www.cvquiltworks.com/shop</u>)

Sewing Machine with a quarter inch foot and accessories Iron (portable is fine and optional) Ironing Mat (portable is fine and optional) One piece of Template Plastic (3" by 12" piece) 12" Add-A-Quarter ruler **Purple Thang** 6" X 12" ruler Medium size cutting mat (18" X 24") New rotary blade Size 70 Microtex sewing machine needles Scissors Seam Ripper (a quilter's best friend... sometimes) Surge protectors **Extension Cords** Fabric Glue or glue pen (Fons and Porter, Sewline, or Avery recommended) High Quality cotton sewing thread Flower pins Scotch tape Large Ziploc bags (2 gallon is best or 1 gallon) Stapler Binder clips, medium Large paper clips

## Fabric Required:

#### 26 Fat Quarters:

These yield enough to make 76 blocks. You should select a good variety of light, medium, and dark fabrics.

## Inner Border:

1/2 Yard

#### **Cornerstones:**

One Fat Quarter each of a light, medium, and dark fabric.

#### **Pre-Class Instructions:**

Pre-cutting the fabrics is a mandatory requirement prior to taking this class. Please begin preparing for class at least 2-3 WEEKS prior to the class to make sure that you are able to get familiar with your pattern and complete the precutting before hand. It is important that you have your pre-class cutting completed. If this step is not completed, you will have a very difficult time keeping up and participating in the instruction.

## First READ through the entire pattern before beginning.

## **Pre-Cutting:**

One fat quarter has enough fabric to make three 6" blocks.

Cut three 6" X 21" strips from each fat quarter. Stack the strips and crosscut them into 6" X 6 3/4" sections. *Each fat quarter yields 9 sections*. Place them in a Ziploc bag and bring to class.
