

# **My 2 Baby Sisters**

## **The following items will be used in class:**

My 2 Baby Sisters Pattern

Sewing machine with a quarter-inch foot

Iron

Ironing board

One piece of template plastic (3" x 12")

12" Add-a-Quarter ruler

Purple thang (optional)

6" x 12" ruler

Medium size cutting mat (18" x 24")

Rotary cutter 45 mm or 60 mm

New rotary blade

Size 70 needles (microtex recommended)

Scissors

Seam ripper

Surge protector

Extension Cord

Fabric glue UHU stic

Glue Pen (Sewline or Fons and Porter recommended)

High quality cotton sewing thread (50 weight recommended)

Flowerhead pins

Scotch tape

Large Ziploc Bags 6~(1 Gallon bags)

Stapler

Binder Clips (Small and Medium)

Large Paper clips

*Pre-cutting the fabrics is a mandatory requirement prior to taking this course. Please begin preparing for class at least **3-WEEKS** prior to the class to make sure that you are able to get familiar with your pattern and complete the pre-cutting before hand. It is important that you have your pre-class cutting completed. If this step is not completed, you will have a very difficult time keeping up and participating in the instruction. We recommend reading through your entire pattern before beginning.*

**Fabric Selection:** Please refer to the yardage chart on the back of your pattern for more information.

**Preparing the Template sheets:** Please refer to “**Template Layout Sheets**” on page 2 of your pattern.

**Preparing the Foundation Papers:** Please refer to **Foundation Papers** on page 2 of your pattern. Read how to prepare the foundation papers and then... ***have 16 of each of the following cut PRIOR to class:***

*Unit LSR Place in Bag #2 and LSL Place in Bag #1, Unit SSR Place in Bag#4 and SSL Place in Bag #3, BZ Place in Bag #5*

**Cutting Instructions:** Read through “**General Cutting instructions**” on page 3 through 5 of your pattern before beginning.

**Large Star Background:**

Cut (6) 10 1/2” X 42” strips, open the strips and subcut them into 10 1/2” X 20 1/2” rectangles. Place in Bag #1 for now.

**Large and Small Right Star Points:**

1. Stack all (6) star point fabrics (colors R1 - R6)
2. Cut (1) 5” strip, through all 6 layers. You will have a total of 6 strips.  
Place in Bag #2

3. Cut (2) 3 1/2" strips through all 6 layers. You will have a total of 12 strips. Place in Bag #4

### **Small Star Background**

1. Using the (2) background fabric for the small star backgrounds, cut (4) 7 X 42" Strips from each fabric.
2. Subcut the strips into 7" X 13 1/2" rectangles, keeping the colors separated. Place in Bag #4

### **Left Star Points and Flying Geese Backgrounds**

1. Stack the (6) fabrics chosen for the left star points. (Colors L1-L6) The L6 fabric is a smaller cut than the others, make sure this one is on top of the stack.
2. Cut(1) 5" X 42" strip from the stack to total (6) strips. Set these aside for the large stars. Bag #1
3. Cut (2) 3.5" X 42 strips for a total of (12) strips. Set aside for the small stars. Bag #3

### **Flying Geese Border Backgrounds**

1. Stack the fabrics chosen for the flying geese border. Cut (2) 9 3/4" X 42 strips to total (11). The top fabric (L6) will only need to have (1) 9 3/4" strip, set this (1) strip aside in Bag #6.
2. Open and stack (10) 9 3/4" X 42" **right sides up**, sub cut the strips into 9 3/4" X 8 1/2" rectangles. There are (34) rectangles required. Place in Bag #5

### **Border Geese**

1. From each of the three fabric colors, cut (10) 6" Squares to total (30). Place in Bag #5.

2. If using a striped fabric, cut (9) 3" X 42" Strips, place into Bag #5.
