

Arizona Cactus Quilt

(42" x 42")



Here is your chance to learn one of Judy Niemeyer's newest patterns, learning her easy curved piecing techniques along with streamlining and chaining your pieces to produce a beautiful quilt that will amaze your family and friends. Take this beginning course and learn techniques that will help you in taking on additional challenging patterns of Judy Niemeyer. There is an accompanying table runner – Cactus Flower – that helps complete a themed look.

Supply List:

Purple Thang/Stiletto	Add-a-Quarter Ruler*	3.5 x 13" Plastic Template (for folding)*
Flower Pins	Glue Stick (UHU)	Glue Pen
Gallon Plastic Bags	Large Paper Clips	Metal Black Clips
Rotary Cutter/Blades	Self-healing Cutting Mat	Thread/#70 Needles

At least 6 x 18 grid flat ruler

**Instructor has designed a ruler kit with (6" & 12" Add-a-quarter ruler with matching templates) for sale in class – which is not needed until then – and ruler area is wider to protect your fingers while cutting. (\$17.00)*

**** You will need your normal sewing supplies and sewing machine**

Optional: (Not necessary)

Small iron	Ironing Pad	Light table/Pencil
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Class Preparation: Have all fabric and papers cut out and organized prior to class – pre-class preparation is written clearly in pattern package.

Material Requirements:

Fabric #	Yardage	Usage
Dark #1	5/8 yard	CS-2 & CS-4 Units (inside square background) – 1 st Layer Background Group
Dark #2	1 5/8 yards	CS-2 & CS-4 Units (inside square background) – 2 nd Layer Background Group
Dark #3	7/8 yard	CS-2 & CS-4 Units (inside square background) – 3 rd Layer Background Group
Medium #4	1/4 yard	CS-1 Unit & M- Unit (Large Center Spike) – 1 st Layer Background Group
Medium #5	1/4 yard	CS-1 Unit (Large Center Spike) – 2 nd Layer Background Group
Medium #6	1/4 yard	CS-1 Unit (Large Center Spike) – 3 rd Layer Background Group
Light #7	1/2 yard	CS-3 Unit (Accompanying color to Large Center Spike)- All Groups
Light #8	1/2 yard	CS-5 Unit (Accompanying color to Large Center Spike) – All Groups
Light #9	1/2 yard	M-Unit (Background on Small Star Clusters)
**		Small Star clusters are a combination of Dark 1; Dark 2; and Dark 3 colors

A good rule of thumb – is to purchase additional fabric in each color – any amount from ¼ yard should do. This is just in case you might run short – and mistakes can happen while cutting or piecing. Save your scraps – you could possibly need them later...
